Mousata is situated in the southern part of Kefalonia. Its location and picturesque character captivate visitors, as does the neighbouring village of Poriarata. Lush greenery dominates the landscape, as the villages are built on the foothills of Mount Ainos, surrounded by shrubs and olive trees. The area is also very close to the beautiful sandy Trapezaki Beach, renowned for its shallow, crystal-clear waters. The name Mousata is believed to derive from the toponym “Amousses”, which locals interpret as “the village of sand”, referring to the sandy deposits carried by the nearby stream. A distinctive feature of the village is its traditional bakery, which produces fresh bread and pastries distributed throughout the island.

History

According to Homer, Kefalonia and Ithaca, together with Zakynthos, Lefkada and part of mainland Acarnania, formed the kingdom of the resourceful and much-travelled hero Odysseus. During the Mycenaean period, the islands flourished, achieving significant cultural and social development. Their inhabitants evolved into skilled seafarers, following the example of the daring Odysseus. Ithaca, capital of the state of the “Kephallenians” – a term first mentioned in Homer’s Iliad and generally referring to Odysseus’ subjects – became one of the most powerful states of the era and an important commercial center of mainland Greece and Corinth.

At the same time, Kefalonia was divided into four administrative regions corresponding to today’s districts of Krani, Sami, Pali and Pronni. This formation was referred to as the “Tetrapolis” by Thucydides, and its name is attributed to the four sons of Cephalus, the mythical hero said to have given the island its name.

The year 1500 marks a milestone in the island’s history, as the period of Venetian rule begins – a time characterised by strong social and class distinctions. Until 1797, Kefalonia served as a strategic hub for Venetian ships. In 1757, the capital was transferred to Argostoli.

Through the centuries, successive rulers left their mark, shaping a unique and rich cultural heritage and giving rise to the distinctive Ionian culture, which continues to influence the character of its people. The progressive Kefalonian spirit has absorbed foreign influences with creativity and openness.

Local traditions, customs, dialects, songs and festivals have been preserved and evolved through art, music, dance and theatre. In 1857, the first theatre, named “Kephalos”, was founded.

Musical traditions include the “Arietta”, originating from Lixouri and performed by three or four singers, as well as serenades, popular songs accompanied by guitar. Philharmonic orchestras were established in Lixouri and Argostoli and continue to operate to this day. Traditional dances such as Ballos, Syrto and Koutsos maintain their unique character and are still danced during celebrations, festivals, the Kefalonian Carnival and other cultural events.

Architecturally, local houses reflect simplified Renaissance and Baroque influences. Although many mansions were destroyed during the 1953 earthquakes, they were rebuilt with respect for their original character. In Ithaca, many stone-built houses with wooden doors and windows remain preserved.

Kefalonian wood carving is evident in the exquisite wooden icon screens of churches and monasteries, as well as in religious icons.
